The 2009 Jury of the EFQM Excellence Award are individuals representing all categories of the award from large industry to family-owned SMEs and includes previous award winners. The jury members are comprised of, among others, CEOs and Senior Executives of BT Global Services, Grundfos, Dexia Sofaxis as well as high level representatives from the Public Sector.

EFQM brings together organisations striving for sustainable excellence. EFQM has spent over 20 years sharing what works between its member organisations to help them implement their strategies. The EFQM network comprises a highly diverse set of organisations that represent all business sizes, segments and public institutions – many of which operate across the globe.

The EFQM Forum, 28-29 September in Brussels, includes a celebration dinner to announce the annual winners of the EFQM Excellence Award. The Award, which is given to Europe's best performing companies and not-for-profit organisations, is Europe's most prestigious award for organisational Excellence.
